### **Loudon Hazard Mitigation Plan 2016 Public Information Meeting on June 7**

**LOUDON:** June 7, 2016 - Local community leaders are taking steps to reduce the effects of Loudon's next natural, technological or human disaster event, including flooding. A Hazard Mitigation Committee comprised of Town Departments, Boards, emergency personnel, and community stakeholders has completed development of the Town's updated draft **Loudon Hazard Mitigation Plan 2016**. This updated Plan is required to be approved by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) every five years to maintain continued eligibility for federal disaster and project funding.

A PUBLIC INFORMATION MEETING will be held on **Tuesday, June 7 from 5:30 – 6:00 PM at the Community Building, 29 South Village Road** in Loudon prior to the Board of Selectmen's meeting to discuss the Plan and to listen to public feedback on the document. All are invited to attend and participate.

The draft **Loudon Hazard Mitigation Plan Update 2016** and the associated Maps of the Plan will be available for review at the Town Office and the Library after May 31.
