

Selectmen's Meeting Minutes

Tuesday, July 26, 2005

**Present: Selectman Bowles and Maxfield. Chairman Kardaseski was not present.
Also present: Road Agent David Rice.**

Selectman Bowles called the meeting to order at 6:30 PM.

- I. Selectman Maxfield moved to approve the Selectmen's Meeting Minutes of Tuesday, July 19, 2005 as presented. Seconded by Selectman Bowles. All in favor. Motion carried.

- II. The Board met with Road Agent David Rice.
 - a. Mr. Rice stated Pike Industries would be paving the shoulders on School Street as soon as they can get back. Mr. Rice stated people on School Street have been getting information from the Post Office stating they need to fill in front of their mail boxes.
 - b. Selectman Bowles asked if there was anything that could be done while Pike was in Town to fix the area in front of Capital Fire Protection. Mr. Rice said they planned on filling in the "drop" in the old asphalt.
 - c. Selectman Maxfield asked if yellow lines were going to be painted on School Street. Mr. Rice stated they would be putting the yellow stripe on as well as the white "fog" line.
 - d. Selectman Maxfield stated Glenn White had been grading and raking the dirt roads and he felt Mr. White was doing a good job.
 - e. Selectman Bowles stated one item on the correspondence list regarding a road issue on Staniels Road. Mr. Rice stated they had gone down with the loader. Mr. Rice will get someone to fill in with cold patch.
 - f. Selectman Bowles advised Mr. Rice there will be a site walk at Chip Davis's property on Lovejoy Road on Wednesday, at 3:00 PM. He stated there will be discussion regarding the road and wanted Mr. Rice to attend if possible.

- III. The Board met with Arthur Colby.
 - a. Mr. Colby discussed the Honor Roll Memorial at the Maxfield Public Library. He asked that the Board consider leaving the Honor Roll Memorial that is currently in place and still put in the new Memorial. Selectman Maxfield explained what the new Memorial would be like.

- IV. The Board began their review of weekly correspondence.
 - a. The Board received a response from Central NH Haz-Mat Team regarding pay rates.
 - b. The Board received the June ESMI compliance report.
 - c. The Board received a copy of a letter from Michael Reifke to Wetlands Board regarding a violation.
 - d. The Board received the Town's copy of the Freedom Hill Coop CDBG grant application.

Selectman Bowles moved to adjourn the meeting at 7:10 PM. Seconded by Selectman Maxfield. All in favor. Meeting adjourned.
