

SELECTMEN'S MEETING MINUTES TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 24, 2009

**PRESENT: Selectmen Bowles and Ives. Selectman Maxfield is absent this evening.
No Department Heads were present for tonight's meeting.**

Chairman Bowles called the meeting to order at 6:30 P.M.

- I. Selectman Ives moved to approve the Selectmen's Meeting Minutes of Tuesday, November 17, 2009 as written. Second by Chairman Bowles. Majority vote. Motion carried.
- II. The Board began their review of weekly correspondence.
 - a. The Board received a memo from Planning Board Chairman Tom Dow in regards to the Planning Board's decision on the winter event proposed for NH Motor Speedway.
 - b. The Board noted receipt of a letter from Town of Canterbury Selectmen in regards to the Planning Board discussion on November 19, 2009 for the proposed winter event for NH Motor Speedway.
 - c. The Board acknowledged receipt of correspondence from Town of Canterbury Town Administrator Roger A. Becker in regards to the winter event proposed by NH Motor Speedway. Mr. Becker's letter addresses Canterbury's opinion this would be a regional impact proposal.
 - d. The Board received copies of a summary judgment submitted by Attorney Barton Mayer on Loudon's behalf in regards to Greenview Drive.
 - e. The Board received a copy of a letter from DES in regards to the storm water and sediment control plan submitted by Rob and Judy Hamilton.
 - f. The Board received a copy of the funds encumbered for the town hall repairs.
 - g. The Board reviewed information on the City of Keene woodstove replacement plan, which is the result of a grant they received from DES. The grant is based on air quality issues experienced within the city.
 - h. The Board received one past due ambulance bill for review. Selectman Ives moved to forward account #42706 in the amount of \$545.10 to collection. Second by Chairman Bowles. All in favor. Motion carried.
 - i. The Board received copies of a letter from Peter and Cheryl Geerdes in regards to posting of their property which is in current use assessment. This letter will be forwarded to Assessor Dave Wiley for review.
 - j. The Board received a thank you letter from Rocky Pond Association for the town's contribution toward milfoil removal from Rocky Pond.
