

## **Loudon Recreation Meeting Minutes for September 25, 2008**

**Meeting began at 6:30pm.**

**Budget reviewed. The Loudon Recreation will request an executive session with the Selectman to discuss the present budget as well as future planning. The Committee did not meet with the Selectman on September 9<sup>th</sup> as suggested in the last meeting minutes.**

**The Recreation Field Playground Equipment is due to arrive the week of October 6<sup>th</sup>. Dave Rice has removed the old playground due to it's poor condition and has prepared the area. Alicia Grimaldi will send out an email to people who have expressed an interest in helping to set it up and if others are interested in assisting can contact her at #435-5193. The date chose to set the equipment up is Columbus Day, October 13<sup>th</sup>.**

**Ballroom Dancing flyers have gone out – notices were sent to the papers and placed around town as well as going out through the elementary school. This is an adult class, which is appropriate for singles and couples taught by instructor, Ann Wilson. The minimum class size is 4 and maximum 24. The cost is \$60 per person and the class would run 6 weeks and will be held at Loudon Elementary School in the cafeteria.**

**It was determined that the ice rink is damaged and will not be put up this year. The committee would like to discuss with the Selectman regarding a ice rink/roller rink to be constructed in the future. This would be much less maintenance then the rink we have been using. Christine Campbell will research and obtain pictures to show the Selectman.**

**The Recreation Committee has chose to fund the Maxfield Public Library Passes due to the library's budget cut. The Committee feels this is a valuable program to offer the community. Amanda Masse to follow up with Director, Nancy Hendy.**

**The Loudon Recreation Committee will create vacation calendars with local events for the kids to do over Christmas and February vacation. Christine Campbell will contact local businesses to see if they are interested in holding a small program. The programs will be free or have a nominal fee. Christine Campbell and Amanda Masse will create the calendar to be distributed before the holiday break.**
