

LOUDON COMMUNICATIONS COUNCIL MINUTES OF FEBRUARY 19, 2007 AT THE COMMUNITY BUILDING – CHARLIE’S BARN, ON VILLAGE ROAD.

- I. Advertising Reports – Samantha French reported on her ad sales for the March issue. She has one new ad, six ads with another six more coming in the mail tomorrow (delayed due to holiday). Next month she has a couple contract renewals and will be working on landscapers and possible Easter advertisers.
- II. Publication Coordinator – Deb Kardaseski reported on the very full March 2007 issue. Numerous organizations submitted information about their news and events. Candidate’s night info and the warrant will be added to the issue. For the April issue town meeting results, spring planting and spring sports will likely be a focus.
- III. Secretary’s Report – Amanda Masse distributed the minutes of January via email and brought copies to the meeting. Those present reviewed the minutes. A motion was made by Dottie Mulkhey to accept the minutes; with a second by Raymond Cummings, the minutes were accepted.
- IV. Treasurer’s Report – Treasurer Dorothy Mulkhey read the income and expense report for December and January. For the month of December the beginning balance was \$17,775.74. There were deposits of \$2,880.67 and there were expenses of \$1,272.37. The ending balance for December was \$19,384.04. Deb Kardaseski noted that the bill for the 4-part NCR paper was paid twice. It was decided to void check #104 in the amount of \$18.00 as Deb had received the payment (ck#111). This correction would change the ending balance to \$19,402.04. For the month of January the beginning balance (with the correction) was \$19,402.04. There were deposits of \$2,729.00 and there were expenses of \$2,020.63. The ending balance for January was \$20,110.41. A motion was made by Amanda Masse to accept the Treasurer’s reports with the one correction; with a second by Kris Tripp, the corrected reports were accepted.
- V. Website Update – Emily Bracey was unable to attend the meeting. Amanda will check the website to be sure the advertisements are up to date. Raymond Cummings questioned the status of the tax warrant being available on the website. We will wait to hear the progress at the next meeting. Amanda noted that Dottie had paid the bill for the domain name to be registered for another 5 years.
- VI. Old Business-
 - a. New Member Recruit –Council members will continue to spread the word for individuals looking to volunteer for the Council.

A motion was made by Amanda Masse to adjourn, with a second by Dorothy Mulkhey, the meeting adjourned at 7:22 p.m. The next meeting of The Loudon Communications Council will be held on Monday, March 19th at 6:30 p.m. at The Community Building - Charlie’s Barn in the village.
