

HOW TO RECYCLE IN LOUDON

MIXED PAPER (includes newspaper)

Magazines, phone books, paperback books, office paper, catalogs, mailings, cereal boxes, paper bags, beer/soda carriers, newspaper and inserts. If it tears, you can recycle it.

CARDBOARD

Corrugated cardboard only. Flatten boxes; no need to remove labels or staples. Empty pizza boxes are OK.

CLOTHING

Clean items of clothing in good condition, footwear, stuffed animals, and bedding.

COMPOST

Leaves, and yard vegetation. No brush. Kitty litter if removed from container.

TIN CANS

Please empty and rinse. No need to flatten or remove labels. Metal lids from glass jars, bi-metal cans, empty aerosol cans. Empty, dried paint cans are also accepted.

Glass

Glass bottles and jars only. Rinse out, remove caps, and stoppers. No window glass or cookware.

ALUMINUM

Soda and beer cans only. Rinse out beverage cans and deposit in receptacle provided. No cat food cans, pie plates, or aluminum foil. (These are a different grade.)

PLASTIC

Only #1 and #2 plastic items are acceptable. Food or beverage containers should be emptied completely and rinsed. Caps or covers should be removed and discarded. Automotive oil, anti-freeze, or other toxic chemical containers are not allowed.

RIGID PLASTICS

Most large plastic items, including: plastic furniture, toys, clean pails, crates, carts, baskets, barrels, etc. No house siding, PVC pipe, or electronics.
